Dr. Anand is internationally known for his work in endoscopic sinus surgery and anterior skull base surgery. He is a clinical professor of otolaryngology at the Weill Cornell Medical College and the director of the rhinology laboratory.

Dr. Schwartz has received numerous awards for his pioneering research in the surgical treatment of brain tumors and epilepsy. He is an associate professor of neurosurgery at Weill Cornell Medical College and the director of brain tumor, epilepsy and pituitary surgery.
